#### Freeze Warning Tips

- \* Be sure to drip inside hot and cold faucets.
- \* Keep thermostat at 60 degrees or above.
- \* Open cupboard doors in bathrooms on outside walls.
- \* Cover outside water faucets.

#### Why is Water Important?

- \* Every living thing on the planet earth needs water to live and grow.
- \* About 70% of the Earth is covered by water.
- \* Water also makes up about 70% of the human body.
- \* People should drink about 6 glasses of water a day to stay healthy.



#### Reduce Bills
