## Save Water & Money

The District has a year-round voluntary water conservation schedule (visit [www.bcmud.org](http://www.bcmud.org) for complete program details). Please conserve water especially during the summer months.

At all times when mandatory conservation requirements are not in effect, users are requested to voluntarily limit the use of water for non-essential purposes and to practice water conservation in accordance with the following voluntary watering schedule:

Odd-numbered addresses water on odd-numbered days of the month. Even-numbered addresses water on even-numbered days of the month.

In the event no address number exists for the outdoor water use location, users are requested to voluntarily restrict water use to even-numbered days only.

## Summer Water Rates

The water rate increases from \$2.10 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.75 per 1,000 gallons during the months of June through September. Conserving water has a positive impact on your water bills. Visit [www.bcmud.org](http://www.bcmud.org) for water conservation tips.

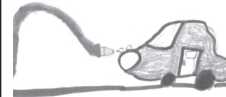

#### Adam's Water Conservation Tip:



Use a bucket of soapy water to wash your car instead of leaving the hose running. (From Mrs. Brunson's 2nd Grade Class at Great Oaks Elementary School.)

#### Cross-Connection ?

Q: What is a cross-connection?

A: A cross-connection is any connection from your home line to water of a lesser quality.

Q: How does it affect you and your home?

A: A cross-connection can allow potentially harmful water into your home undetected.

One of the most common cross-connections found at residential homes is the water hose. When a hose is left in a bucket of soap, in a pool, or connected to an aspirator with chemicals, then under the right conditions it could be pulled back into your home line potentially contaminating your water.
