How to Conserve Water in the Bathroom

75% of water usage is in the bathroom. Toilets use the most water in the house, wasting more than 40% more water than needed.

- ★ Turn off water while brushing teeth.
- ★ Don't use the toilet as a wastebasket. Every flush wastes 3-7 gallons of water.
- ★ Take short five minute showers instead of baths.

Sewer Averaging Update

Each year during the months of November through February, the District averages water consumption to determine your sewer charge. Your bill due in May will be the first bill with the new sewer average cost. If you have any questions, please contact Customer Service 255-7871 x2.
