



BRUSHY CREEK MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT PARKS AND POOLS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR 2007

I. SWIMMING POOLS.

A. An accessible lift is located at Sendero Springs Pool and is available for persons needing assistance with entry to the pool.

(Note - As attendance varies, the pools may be opened on an alternate basis and will also be dependent on available staff. The hours and days will be posted at the pools. Revised hours will be posted at the pools, the MUD office and on the MUD website, www.bcmud.com/swimming.html)

B. Swim Team Hours. Sendero Springs Pool shall be closed for use by the Brushy Creek Marlins Team and/or other groups in accordance with contracts approved by the Brushy Creek MUD Board of Directors. A revised schedule for pool hours will be made available as changes are made.

** 2 lanes MAY be available for lap swimming during SOME Swim Team practices. If a BCMUD lifeguard is not present, public swim is not available.

C. Swim Lessons and closures. **Creekside Pool** shall be closed for swimming lessons for the following dates and hours:
May 28 – Aug 2 (Evening swim lessons Sessions I – V)
Monday through Thursday - 5:30pm until 7:30pm

Sendero Springs Pool shall be closed for Marlins Swim Team for the following dates and hours:
May 28– July 8
Monday through Friday 8:30am – 1pm

Cat Hollow Pool shall be closed for swimming lessons for the following dates and hours:
May 28 – July 6 (Morning swim lessons Sessions I – V)
Monday through Thursday – 9am until 10:30am

All pools shall be closed for staff training for the following dates and hours:
May 28– Aug 31
Fridays – 8:00 am until 10 am

D. Closing of Pools. The General Manager has the authority to close and or limit the number of patrons at any of the Brushy Creek pools when health or safety standards deem it necessary. Also, the General Manager may close one of the pools if pool usage does not warrant all pools remaining open to the public.

II. POOL FEES AND CHARGES.

A. **Swim Passes.** Year Round swim passes for District residents and members of the Community Center shall cost \$25.00 each for the first two passes purchased and \$20.00 for each additional pass purchased per residential household thereafter. Identification shall be required for proof of residency in the Brushy Creek MUD or proof of Community Center membership for the purchase of each pass. Children, age 4 and older, at the time of purchase of passes, are required to purchase a swim pass. Passes purchased before April 4th will receive one free day pass coupon for each pass purchased. Replacement swim passes are available at the Community Center at a cost of \$5.00 each. No refunds will be issued.

Access to the District's recreational facilities is gained through the use of an automated photo identification card for each person. Access to the District pools will not be granted without a photo ID swim pass.

B. **Day Passes.** Day passes (a stamp) shall be sold at \$4.00 per person, per day for all individuals that do not have a District Swim pass. This \$4.00 is extended to all ages under 65. If you are with a person who has a swim pass then the swim pass owner can bring an equivalent number of people in at \$2.00 each. (A child or infant that is not accompanied by a family member that is a swim pass holder must pay the appropriate admission). Senior citizens (over the age of 65) will be charged \$1.00 per person, per day.

C. **Out-of-District Passes.** Passes will be sold to out-of-District residents who are not Community Center members for a flat fee of \$150.00 per family plus the purchase price of the actual swim passes.

D. Public Access to the Pool. All swim pass holders have access to all scheduled times that the pool is open with the following stipulations:

1. The pass has not been withheld for limited or extended time due to disciplinary actions.
2. Any child 3 years or younger is considered to be a swim pass holder as long as that child is accompanied by a Brushy Creek MUD family member that is a swim pass holder.
3. All children ten (10) years and under must be accompanied by an individual 16 years or older at all times. No adult may bring more than four (4) children under 10 years old.

E. Change of Status: If any pool activity drops below 50% Brushy Creek MUD swim pass holder participation, the MUD Board may be obligated to revise the pool usage schedule regarding that activity.

III. POOL RULES.

A. The following is a list of rules for the pool areas:

1. No running is allowed.
2. No diving in the shallow end is permitted.
3. No loitering is permitted around the lifeguard stands.
4. Only children 8 years and under and supervisors are allowed in the baby pool.
5. Children unable to independently swim the length of the pool must be within an adult's body length of the supervising person, who shall be over sixteen (16) years of age.
6. Swim diapers only, no regular diapers allowed.
7. Lifeguards provide backup support for supervising adults of children.
8. U.S. Coast Guard life jackets and floats are permitted.
9. Only toys or objects designed for use in the water and less than 30" in diameter will be allowed.
10. No glass containers are allowed in the pool areas.
11. No smoking is allowed within 15' of the fenced pool area.
12. No BBQ pits are allowed in the pool area.
13. No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, firearms or fireworks will be allowed. *
14. No abusive or foul language will be tolerated. Criminal complaints will be filed when applicable. *
15. Any behavior considered by lifeguards to be dangerous in the pool or the pool area is prohibited. *

Note: * Criminal complaints will be filed when applicable.

IV. PARK RULES.

A. Hours. Spring/Summer: Open from 5:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.
Winter/Fall: Open from 6:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.

B. Rules.

1. No smoking is allowed within 15' of the playground areas.
2. No littering is allowed - put trash in receptacles.
3. All pets must be leashed and cleaned up after.
4. No illegal drugs, firearms, fireworks or glass containers are allowed. *
5. No excessive consumption of alcohol is permitted. *
6. No destruction or defacing of structures is allowed.
7. No abusive or foul language will be tolerated. *
8. No Skateboarding or Rollerblading where posted as such.
9. No motorized vehicles will be allowed in any park or greenbelt. *
10. No ground fires are permitted.
11. No harassment of wildfowl and wildlife is allowed.
12. If your event will have 250 people or more, please call 255-7871 for General Manager review.
13. Except as otherwise approved by contract with the District, no concerts, bands or other events with amplified music or sound that may be heard by adjoining property owners are permitted.

Note: * Criminal complaints will be filed when applicable.

V. REPRIMANDS FOR PARK AND POOL RULE VIOLATIONS.

A. Rewards. The District offers a \$500.00 reward for information that leads to the arrest of vandals.

B. For Pool Violations:

- 1) First reprimand is a warning.
- 2) Second reprimand is suspension from the pool for up to 1 hour.
- 3) Third reprimand is suspension from the pool for the remainder of the day.

C. Actions for Serious Violations of parks and pool rules may include:

(In any order depending upon severity of offense)

- 1) Notification of parents or guardian,
- 2) Suspension from pool or park area for an extended period,
- 3) Notification of Sheriff's Department,
- 4) Prosecution, and/or
- 5) Restoration of damaged property and/or fine up to \$200.

Note: Criminal complaints will be filed when applicable.

D. Enforcement.

Enforcement shall be made by any appropriate law enforcement officer, the county Sheriff, Brushy Creek MUD General Manager, or any MUD employee as designated by the General Manager.
