

Water Hardness

The District's water hardness fluctuates depending on the ratio of surface to groundwater that we utilize on a daily basis. However, an annual running average would be about 180 mg/L hardness. To convert mg/L hardness to grains of hardness per gallon, divide hardness expressed in mg/L by 17.1. The result will be hardness in grains per gallon.
