CONTEST RULES:

1. HOW TO REGISTER *(Only One Entry Per Family)*

Early Registration Early registration is highly recommended and preferred to ensure all contestants are properly entered into the contest. Early Registration begins June 1st and closes on June 29th at 3:00 pm.

Contestants wishing to register early may do so by emailing Chloe Loflin (c.loflin@bcmud.org) with a Completed Entry Form.

Contestants who complete the Early Registration process will be allowed to pick up their “Turn-In” Trays on Saturday, June 27th between 9:00 am – 3:00 pm at the Customer Service Desk at the Community Center, located at 16318 Great Oaks Drive, Round Rock, TX 78681

Late Registration Only Occurs the Day of the Event at the 4th of July Parade & Festival on Friday, July 4th from 9:30 am to 10:00 am. Cat Hollow Park is located at (8320 O’Connor Drive, Round Rock, TX 78681). Late Registration Entrants will be required to complete an entry form on site prior to being given any “Turn-In” Trays.

All Contestants must complete the entry form in full and sign the acknowledgment. Entries will be assigned a number, and judging will occur before the contestant’s names are identified. **Turn-in trays may not be altered in any way, nor may they contain any labeling of any kind other than the Category and Entry number provided by the District.**

2. DESSERT-MAKING GUIDELINES

- a. Desserts must be cooked off-site and turned in on the day of the contest and turned in using the “Turn-In” trays provided by the District.
- b. All dessert entries must be made from scratch.
- c. Pre-packaged store-bought brands or commercially available pre-made desserts may not be entered
- d. All desserts must fit in the dimensions of the container, and it must close.

3. **TURNING IN DESSERT ENTRIES**

- a. Dessert must be entered using the “Turn-In” trays provided by the District to the entrants as part of the registration process. These may be picked up according to the information outlined in the “How to Register” section.
 - b. It is highly suggested contestants register early and obtain the “Turn-In” Trays prior to the day of the competition. Desserts may be transferred to the Turn-In Trays at the event, but these must be submitted before the Official Turn-In Time Frame (9:30 am – 10:00 am).
 - c. Entries must be turned in to the Dessert Competition Area located under the Small Pavilion at the 4th of July Parade & Festival.
 - d. Contestants must provide enough samples for ten to fifteen (10-15) individuals to taste the entry.
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DESSERT JUDGING PROCESS:

1. Judging will be performed by volunteers. The judging process will start at 10:00 am under the small Pavilion closest to O’Connor/Playground.
2. Entries will be assigned a number, and judging will take place before the entrants’ names are identified.
3. The total number of judges will be based on the number of entries. Early Registration by contestants will help ensure the total number of judges is secured.
4. **Judging Criteria:** Each dessert entry may earn up to twenty-five (25) points per judge.
 - a. ***Appearance:*** Up to three (3) Points may be given. This is the judge’s review of the overall look of your dessert, and neatness.
 - b. ***Flavor:*** Up to five (5) Points may be given. This is the judge’s review of the taste and the balance of the dessert’s flavoring.
 - c. ***Texture/Consistency:*** Up to five (5) Points may be given. This is the judge’s review of how evenly the dessert is cooked.
 - d. ***Aroma:*** Up to five (5) Points may be given. This is the judge’s review of the dessert entry’s aroma.
 - e. ***Overall:*** Taste Up to seven (7) Points may be given. This is the judge’s review of the overall taste of the dessert entry.
5. **Scoring:** Each judge assigns a numerical value for each category without consultation with the other judges. Each dessert entry may earn up to twenty-five (25) points per judge. The dessert receiving the highest total numerical value is the winner in the competition. Should a tie exist for any of the places, the cumulative score of the “Overall” Criteria will be added together from all judging sheets and the highest score will break the tie.
6. **Prizes:** 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be awarded
