**Due Date:** All water payments are due the 23rd of each month. If the 23rd falls on a weekend or Holiday, payments are due on the next business day.



## Summer Water Rates

The water rate increases from \$2.25 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.95 per 1,000 gallons during the months of June through September. Conserving water has a positive impact on your water bills. Visit [www.bcmud.org](http://www.bcmud.org) for water conservation tips.



## Illicit Discharge

An illicit discharge is any discharge to the stormwater system that is not composed entirely of stormwater. Non-stormwater discharged into our storm drain system enters directly into streams and rivers.

Many seemingly harmless household activities, such as dumping yard waste, draining swimming pools or household waste water from washing machines, dishwashers and water softening devices into ditches, storm drains and sidewalk grates are also classified as illicit discharges. These activities can and do cause severe problems in our waterways. Please be careful with what you put on your lawn, what drips on your driveway, or what blows across your yard. These can all do harm to our neighboring waterways.
