Water-Efficient Products Sales Tax Holiday

May 27-29, 2023

The Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to support and buy from Texas businesses while saving money on tax-free purchases of certain water-efficient and water-conserving products during the annual Texas Water-Efficient Products Sales Tax Holiday. There is no limit on the number of qualifying items you can buy, and you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy items tax free.



The 2023 holiday begins Saturday, May 27, and goes through Monday, May 29 (Memorial Day).

WaterSense Products

During the holiday period, you can buy any product tax free that displays a WaterSense® label or logo. These items can be bought for either personal or business purposes.

Water-Conserving Products

You can also buy certain water-conserving products tax free during the holiday period. Unlike WaterSense®-labeled items, these items are only exempt when you buy them for use at your residential property.

Examples of items that qualify for the exemption include:

- A soaker or drip-irrigation hose
- A moisture control for a sprinkler or irrigation system
- Mulch
- A rain barrel or an alternative rain and moisture collection system
- A permeable ground cover surface that allows water to reach underground basins, aquifers or water collection points
- · Plants, trees and grasses
- Water-saving surfactants
- Soil and compost
